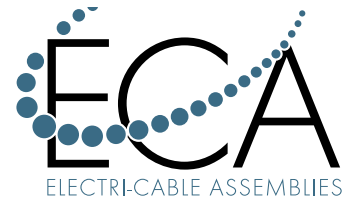


PROJECT PROFILE



CHALLENGE

The University of Michigan, Ross School of Business, is one of the most prestigious business schools in the United States. They undertook a renovation to create an open space environment in their Winter Green area which is the hub of activity for students to gather between classes to grab a snack, study or meet with friends.

As part of the renovation, the Facilities Group at the University was tasked with finding a way to support their students' need to power laptops, tablets and cell phones in this busy area. In addition, the space is used for different functions throughout the year so the furniture and power solutions selected had to be easy to move to allow for reconfiguration of the room.

SOLUTION

ECA's Isle units were selected by the University for their ability to accommodate the power and charging capabilities of many students in one unit. In addition, the Isle is a stand-alone unit, powered by one standard power cord, providing them flexibility in reconfiguring their spaces when current needs changed. The Isle's triangular shape and gloss black finish blended with the table bases and provided a seamless aesthetic of the overall space.
